SALON DISINFECTION CHECK LIST

**All States have required health and public safety rules.
Please reference and follow your State's specific rules to ensure your business is compliant.**

**Salon disinfectant must be EPA-registered and labeled as bactericidal, virucidal and fungicidal.
Follow mixing and safety instructions on the label of EPA-registered disinfectant for proper usage.**

The following is a salon disinfectant checklist.



- ❑ **Styling Stations:** clean and disinfect between each client service.
 - ❑ **Combs** ❑ **Brushes** ❑ **Electric Razors** (guide & blade) ❑ **Clippers** (guide & blade) ❑ **Other implements** used on hair: clean with warm water and soap, rinse thoroughly, dry with a clean towel. Completely immerse in an EPA-registered disinfectant that is labeled as bactericidal, virucidal and fungicidal for 10 minutes. Rinse, dry and store in a covered container. Disinfectant should be changed daily.

- ❑ **Shampoo Stations:** clean and disinfect between each client service.
 - ❑ **Combs** ❑ **Brushes** ❑ **Other implements** that are used on hair: clean with warm water and soap, rinse thoroughly, dry with a clean towel. Completely immerse in an EPA-registered disinfectant that is labeled as bactericidal, virucidal and fungicidal for 10 minutes. Rinse, dry and store in a covered container. Disinfectant should be changed daily. ❑ **Sinks:** spray with an EPA-registered disinfectant. Let stand for 10 minutes and wipe or let air dry.

- ❑ **Manicure Stations:** cleaned and disinfected between each client service.

Disposable items shall be used (one per client) then disposed of properly.

 - ❑ **Combs** ❑ **Cuticle Nippers** ❑ **Pushers** ❑ **Clippers** ❑ **Electric File Bits** ❑ **Tweezers** ❑ **Finger Bowls** ❑ **Nail Files/Buffers** (Reusable) ❑ **Other implements** used on nails: clean with warm water and soap, rinse thoroughly, dry with a clean towel. Completely immerse in an EPA-registered disinfectant that is labeled as bactericidal, virucidal and fungicidal for 10 minutes. Rinse, dry and store in a covered container. Disinfectant should be changed daily.

- ❑ **Pedicure Stations:** clean and disinfect between each client service.

Disposable items shall be used (one per client) then disposed of properly.

 - ❑ **Combs** ❑ **Cuticle Nippers** ❑ **Pushers** ❑ **Clippers** ❑ **Electric File Bits** ❑ **Nail Files/Buffers** (Reusable) ❑ **Other implements** used on nails or skin: clean with warm water and soap, rinse thoroughly, dry with a clean towel and completely immersed in EPA-registered disinfectant that is labeled as bactericidal, virucidal and fungicidal for 10 minutes. Rinse, dry and store in a covered container. Disinfectant should be changed daily.

- ❑ **Footbaths:** empty and clean with warm water and soap, rinse thoroughly. Spray with an EPA-registered disinfectant and let stand for 10 minutes.

- ❑ **Pedicure Spas:** empty and fill with proper mix of water and EPA-registered disinfectant that is labeled as bactericidal, virucidal and fungicidal. Run unit for 10 minutes and drain. Spray the entire chair with an EPA-registered disinfectant and let stand for 10 minutes and wipe or let air dry.

- ❑ **Linens:** discard into a covered container marked “Dirty” after each client. Clean towels, sheets, etc. provided to each client.

- ❑ **Hand Washing:** performed by each practitioner with liquid soap from a dispenser and water for at least 20 seconds before and after each service. Disposable paper towels are recommended for drying.

- ❑ **Blood Spills:** stop service immediately! Place cotton, paper towels, paper files, etc. that are containing blood into a double plastic bag and dispose in a covered trash container. Any implements that were being used shall be disinfected before continuation of service. Disposable items should be thrown out and use a new one before continuation of service.

- ❑ **MSDS Sheets** must be readily available for every product used in the salon (shampoo, nail polish, polish remover, disinfectants, etc.).

- ❑ **Storage of Chemicals** Do not store on their side and avoid extreme temperatures and/or sunlight. Chemicals must be stored in covered containers and covers should be kept tight to protect against cross contamination. Be sure to label all containers once you have mixed disinfectants (Spray bottles, jars, disinfecting trays, etc.). All fluids and powders must be dispensed with a shaker, pump or spray type of container. All creams and lotions must be kept in closed containers and dispensed with a disposable applicator. No “double dipping.”
